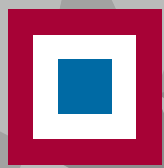

NOTE: *What follows is an unfinished draft of an assessment produced in the early summer of 2024 to explain the Color Revolution aspects of October 7, 2023.*

The assessment was never completed because it became OBE (overcome by events) due to events surrounding Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's speech before Congress on July 25, 2024.

Because the assessment raised points that needed to be surfaced, the decision was made to publish it. Aside from correcting grammatical and structural errors, the draft assessment published below is "as is."

BLUF:

This report argues that recent events in Israel and the United States are not isolated incidents but are part of a coordinated global revolutionary cycle, characterized by color revolution tactics and political warfare.

It states that internal destabilization, ideological conflict, and the merging of Marxist and Islamic movements are being used to undermine national institutions and reshape societies, with October 7, 2023, in Israel presented as a key example of these dynamics.

FIVE KEY POINTS**1. Color Revolution Tactics in Israel and the U.S.**

- Both Israel and the United States are experiencing coordinated color revolution tactics, with the 2020 U.S. events (Purple Revolution) and the Israeli Supreme Court crisis that led to October 7, 2023 (Black Revolution).

2. Internal Destabilization and Ideological Conflict

- Internal destabilization is driven by ideological conflicts, with Marxist and Islamic movements interoperable to undermine national institutions and reshape societies through information campaigns and mass protests.

3. Role of Key Figures and Open Communications

- The actions and rhetoric of figures like Ehud Barak and Shikma Bressler, who are portrayed as leaders of the Israeli Left, are using open communications to coordinate opposition and potentially encourage military insubordination or coups.

4. International Synchronization and Influence Operations

- A global revolutionary cycle, with international actors (such as the Muslim World League, China, and the United Nations) are synchronizing efforts to influence events in Israel and the West, including preplanned media and legal campaigns following October 7.

5. Weaponization of Narratives and Alliances

- Terms like 'fascist,' 'nazi,' and 'right-wing extremist' are strategically used by both Marxist and Islamic actors to suppress dissent and isolate groups, while alliances between the Islamic Movement and the Marxist Left are leveraged to advance their objectives across multiple fronts.

These points collectively argue that recent upheavals are part of a broader, orchestrated effort to destabilize and transform societies through political warfare and revolutionary tactics.

INTRODUCTION:

Americans have yet to grasp the reality of the *Color Revolution (Purple)* that was successfully directed against America in 2020, and therefore fail to recognize the urgency of Cicero's quote:

"A nation can survive its fools and even the ambitious. But it cannot survive treason from within. An enemy at the gates is less formidable, for he is known and carries his banner openly. But the traitor moves amongst those within the gate freely, his sly whispers rustling through all the alleys, heard in the very halls of government itself."

It should come as no surprise, then, that the Israelis are also reluctant to confront the consequences of their Color Revolution (Black).

It becomes even more difficult when the effects of the Purple merge with the Black, compounding the consequences in a period already disorienting amid a global revolution.

In the early phases of a revolution, disorientation among target populations, along with demoralization, is a prerequisite.

The evidence that we are living through a revolutionary cycle — global in scope and local in impact — is abundant. This assessment assumes a color-revolution character for today's events.

Assessments that assume we are living in normal times and under normal governing circumstances when explaining events will miss the mark, falling back on templated lines of action.

Terms like "programmed" and "anticipated" reveal the synthetic nature of events driven by, and driving, information campaigns designed to control the targeted population's action/reaction cycles, from the narrative's inception through its life cycle to its conclusion.

- If America were operating under normal conditions, with open communications by *HAMAS*, *Hezbollah*, and *AnsarAllah* in plain view of the national leadership, no less, while executing their planned and choreographed mass direct actions targeting critical infrastructure, the DNI would respond in a manner consistent with its constitutional responsibilities to safeguard U.S. national security.
- If America were operating under normal conditions, when large swarming protesters take to the streets in open support of HAMAS, the DNI (Director of National Intelligence) would consult with the Secretary of State and the Secretary of the Treasury to confirm HAMAS's official status as a terrorist organization and direct the Attorney General to take legal action to suppress such criminal acts as providing material support.

And to our good fortune, the Biden administration added a second layer of assurance: the DNI, Avril Haines; the Secretary of State, Anthony Blinken; the Secretary of the Treasury, Janet Yellen; and the US Attorney General, Merrick Garland, are all Jewish.

Had circumstances been normal, these protesters would have been suppressed before they even began.

The problem is that we are not living in normal times.

Not only are swarming anti-Jewish/anti-Israel protesters taking to the streets, but there are powerful indicators that their actions are not only tolerated but also sanctioned by the very governing authorities that are legally obligated to protect citizens, including Jewish American citizens, from such direct-action violence.

They are not protesters. They are a mix of Marxist insurgents and Hamas-affiliated Islamic militants.

In fact, they are the same groups that took to the streets in 2020.¹ When the *counter-state*² controls the state, “sanctions” bear a close resemblance to state sponsorship of terrorism directed against America’s own citizens.

In the Biden administration, political fidelity to far-left ideologies overrides both religious affiliation and national identity. Marcuse’s³ dream may now be a reality.

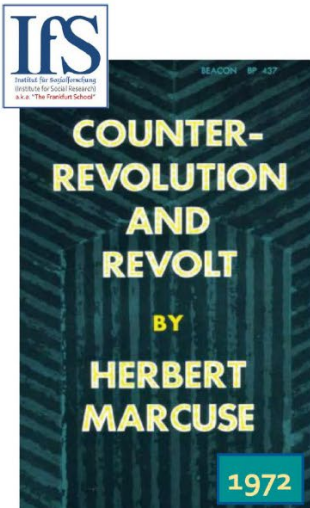

² “*Deep state*” is the popular media-driven term that replaces “*counter-state*,” a *bona fide* political warfare term. Hence, “*counter-state*” is also associated with operational schemas associated with political warfare, for example “*counter-state operations*.” Because this paper explains the purge along political warfare lines, and because *counter-state* is associated with political warfare operations, the term “*counter-state*” will be used. This is especially important for the development of radical, "free" media. The fact that the radical Left has no equal access to the great chains of information and indoctrination is largely responsible for its isolation.

How else does one explain the Biden administration's posture, the fact that 61% of Jews polled still favor Biden, or the fact that 47% of Jewish youth believe the Biden administration provides too much support to Israel?

There is nothing normal about this. That said, it's also not something that's 'in the water.'

The remainder of this note will focus on 1) data points supporting the idea of an Israeli *Color Revolution* and 2) data points leading up to October 7 that warned of the Islamic Movement adopting a hostile posture.

PART I.

The following data points focus on the Israeli left's posture leading up to October 7. They assume that the Israeli Supreme Court crisis earlier in 2023 marked the opening phase of the *Black Revolution*. This is not exhaustive.

Ehud Barak

In a March 2023 *Chatham House* interview, Ehud Barak described how the Israeli Supreme Court would override the Knesset's reform law, triggering a legal crisis that would lead to the government's dissolution.

He then described how the leadership (which he claims is part of his clique) of the IDF/DoD/Shin Bet/Mossad *would refuse to follow government orders and possibly execute a military coup*. Because the

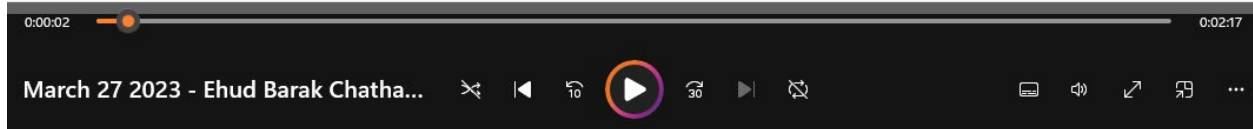
Chatham House interview was a public event available on social media, Barak's statement can be considered an 'open communication.'⁴

Shikma Bressler

On August 16, 2023, *Al Jazeera* published "The True Face of Israel's Protest," focusing on Shikma Bressler as a leader of the Israeli left. *Al Jazeera* highlighted her emphasis on "democracy" and the left's ongoing activities, which were linked to the Supreme Court's reforms. Bressler identified her Israeli opposition as racist.

⁴ As counter-state operations mature, the principal means by which Command-and-Control (C2) is exercised is through "*Open Communications*". For the purpose of this paper, Open Communications in an irregular warfare environment refers to command-and-control techniques that use transparent, accessible communication methods to coordinate operations among counter-state and insurgent actors that are opaque to non-counter-state actors, the uninitiated, while at the same time understandable to target audiences of initiated individuals to which the communications are directed. Open Communications ensures broad, often real-time dissemination of messaging in a manner that enhances collaboration and situational awareness, which are crucial for effective decision-making in complex, fluid conflict environments while remaining secure - *in the clear and in broad daylight*.

- “We can either fall into a very dark, extreme, racist place where the Israel that we know, in all its social and economic aspects, will be destroyed,” she explained to the NYT reporter, “or we can build a new stronger, better democracy for the good of all the people.”

On August 25, 2023, the *Financial Times of London* interviewed Bressler. Because the *Financial Times* is international, her audience was international. Hence, her communications were open.

Bressler linked her activities to a continuation of the court reform crisis, designated Netanyahu a “dictator,” and expressed support for the threat of Israeli reservists not showing up for duty. It’s hard not to associate this rhetoric with those who raise the specter of a coup.

A mobilized international left signals a permissive mutiny against Israel. The article omits mention of Bressler’s penchant for wearing shirts emblazoned with the Marxist clenched fist. In quotes:

- The spark was a contentious judicial overhaul initiated in January by the hard-line new government. But the fight quickly mushroomed into something far bigger: a battle over the country’s identity that has spooked investors, exposed cracks in the military, and deepened the already yawning divides in Israeli society.
- But Bressler remains defiant. “For us, this is the biggest battle of our generation,” she says. “We have no choice but to win. If we lose, this country will still be called Israel. But it won’t be Israel as you thought of it [before].”
- I ask Bressler [about] the government’s overhaul as a way to rein in an overly activist judiciary; and another, more secular and politically heterodox, which sees it as an assault on Israel’s checks and balances that will allow Netanyahu’s ultraorthodox and extreme-right allies to impose their worldview on the rest of society.
- I ask Bressler about the battle consuming Israeli society, which has split the country into two camps: one broadly nationalist and religious that backs the government’s overhaul as a way to rein in an overly activist judiciary; and another, more secular and politically heterodox, which sees it as an assault on Israel’s checks and balances that will allow Netanyahu’s ultraorthodox and extreme-right allies to impose their worldview on the rest of society.
- “It’s astonishing, they are willing to sacrifice the economy, the healthcare system, education system, academia, research, high-tech, our security,” she says, adding that she also worries what the coalition would mean for women’s rights if it were able to act unfettered. “We have places where women need to sit at the back of the buses. It’s there. What I’m saying is you don’t need to guess anything.”
- Bressler insists the protesters are “fighting for all minorities”. But she acknowledges “that our old democracy left behind communities”, and that this has left Israel’s Palestinian citizens feeling they have little stake in the protests. “There is this mistrust, that what we want is actually to maintain a status quo that never did justice to these guys,” she says. “And it’s very obvious for the Arab community because it’s a large minority and the differences are all over the place.”

- One of the protest movement's strongest cards so far — and something that sets Israel apart from Poland — *has been threats from Israeli military reservists not to volunteer for duty if the government continues with its overhaul*. The first wave in March helped force Netanyahu to put the overhaul on ice for three months amid warnings from the defence establishment that Israel's security risked being impaired. *Now, the military is facing an even bigger groundswell, with more than 10,000 reservists from Israel's army and more than 1,100 from its air force saying last month that they would cease to volunteer*. Some government officials have portrayed the refusals as akin to a military coup. Bressler rubbishes the suggestion. For individual reservists, she argues, the decisions are not primarily about exerting leverage. Instead, they are a personal response to government policies. "*People really feel they cannot serve a dictatorship*," she says bluntly.

On September 10, 2023, the *Jewish Press* reported that Bressler identifies her opposition as right-wing Nazis. In an article featuring Bressler wearing a black T-shirt with a clenched fist, the *Jewish Press* labeled Netanyahu and his administration as Nazis and fascists.

When far-left Marxist organizations label people and organizations as Nazis or fascists, they effectively designate them as enemies, placing them on a target list.

- "In other words, according to Bressler, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and his supporters are Jewish Nazis, and therefore any negotiations with him are verboten."
- "It has become commonplace for Israeli leftists to call the right fascists and Nazis with no fear of consequences, as if this is an established truth that requires no supporting evidence. And so, Justice Minister Yariv Levin is a fascist for wishing to restore balance to the three branches of government. MK Simcha Rothman is a fascist for passing Levin's agenda through his Constitution committee, and Netanyahu is a fascist because, you know, he just is."

On October 5, 2023, two days before October 7, the Times of Israel quoted Bressler as saying that Netanyahu was creating a tyranny that threatened democracy.

But this "democracy" is not the one reflected in the fact that the Netanyahu government was elected and, hence, reflects a majority judgment. Rather, it is a democracy along the lines discussed by Ehud Barak at *Chatham House*, as stated above.

This form of "democracy" bears a strong resemblance to the "vanguard of the proletariat" in "People's Democracies."

Whether in Israel or the West more generally, the term "democracy" has taken on a specific initiate connotation that reflects the classical understanding of "democracy" as a revolutionary term that

precedes tyranny. Hence, whether in the U.S. or Israel, “saving our democracy” carries an initiate context that can be understood to mean “save our revolution.”

Of course, Bressler maintains the classical form by declaring Netanyahu a “tyrant.” Hence, one can interpret “fragile democracy” along an initiate path that understands her call for “Democratia” to mean a ‘vulnerable revolution’. As a matter of emphasis, “Democratia” is the Greek **Δημοκρατία** (democratia).

- “Israel is taking the track of becoming a tyranny . . . It means there is someone who is interested in being a tyrant . . . if Israel follows this track, we will no longer be Israel in the way you and I and the people may think about Israel.”
- “But they are doomed to collapse because you cannot force decisions on the vast majority of your people who are against it, unless you decide to use violence against them.” The government argues the proposed reforms are inherently democratic as the coalition was elected by Israeli voters. But Bressler argued that the ballot box mandate “doesn’t give it the right to take democracy away.”
- “In Israel, we have no checks and balances... like others, so our democracy is very, very fragile... Back then, I was shouting ‘*Democratia!*’ [democracy] like the way you hear now on the streets.”
- Israel has a choice, she stressed: “Either a dark road that ends up in tyranny... or to create a much stronger system that will ensure our liberal democratic values for generations to come.”

Other October 7 inputs. What follows is a series of bullet points designed to inform.

- [“‘I will always carry the pain’: IDF Intel Chief Aharon Haliva Resigns over Oct. 7 Failure,”](#) *The Times of Israel*, April 22, 2024
- **Video clip.** Young IDF reservist states that he will always be ready to fight. A video suggesting that many Israeli veterans are aware of the scrutiny they’re under.
- While Haliva is a casualty of Oct. 7, it should not be forgotten that when asked what Israel’s greatest threat was, his answer was global warming.
- **PDF:** “The IDF or the Defense Forces for Leslie Wexner and the Konrad Adenauer Foundation.” Much of Israeli Left funding comes through Germany (the EU). Similar concerns have been raised about the German Marshall Fund (which has no relationship to the Marshall Plan).

 - "Antisemitism is among the worst forms of hatred mankind has ever known. Today, the most visible form of antisemitism is Islamophobia."

PART II.

Not just HAMAS, not just Israel.

October 7 did not simply start a war between Israel and the Palestinians in Gaza. It was the leading edge of a Ummah-level initiative that includes

- the Muslim World League (MWL) Secretary General Sheikh Dr. Mohammed bin Abdulkarim al-Issa's "defamation of Islam" campaign,
- a Pakistani ISI-led Kali operation to undermine Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi,
- Palestinian-branded efforts on college campuses in urban areas throughout the West, and
- the surge in blade attacks, most prominently in Europe.

"Palestinian-branded" because much about these events suggests that, in parallel, they also mark the start of the next round of "*color revolution*" activities that were already fully synchronized and interoperable with the Marxist Left along intersectional lines of operation (LOOs).

In America (and the broader West), the primary objective is to accelerate and weaponize antisemitism to isolate American Jews domestically and Israel internationally.

The street narratives associated with Palestinian protests were prepackaged and synthetic.

Weeks before the November 2020 U.S. presidential election, the U.S. Council of Muslim Organizations held its 2nd International Conference of Muslim Councils of the West from October 20 to 22, 2020.

At this seminal gathering, senior leaders from the global Islamic Movement and the Muslim Brotherhood analyzed perceived threats posed by Islamophobia, White Supremacy, and the Far Right. (Source: [USCMO Flyer](#))



Through the phases of operation in the West, the Islamic Movement has publicly identified and labeled President Donald J. Trump, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, and Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi as obstacles.

The interchangeable use of terms such as 'fascist,' 'nazi,' 'right-wing extremist,' and 'Zionist' to describe Trump, Netanyahu, and Modi by both the Islamic Movement and Marxist Left actors is intended as pejoratives to advance the *Global South* narrative in its ongoing active measure campaigns.

The intended outcome of this curated terminology is to suppress meaningful criticism of the global interfaith operation led by the MWL (in coordination with the OIC), as demonstrated by the strategic alliance formed by U.S. Pastor Bob Roberts, Jr., with MWL Secretary-General Al-Issa, the Islamic Movement, the Muslim Brotherhood, and the Marxist Left.

In his role as an influential leader within the evangelical Christian community, Roberts, Jr. advances the narrative of the global Islamic Movement and the Marxist Left, including the Khalistani operation led by the Pakistani ISI.

- Roberts, Jr., including MWL Secretary-General Al-Issa, has a demonstrated history of advancing the objectives of the global Islamic Movement at the expense of the security and well-being of Jews and Christians.
- Additionally, his efforts to advance the narrative of the Islamic Movement and the Marxist Left on Christian Nationalism and Islamophobia have been used by these actors in their meetings with the USG to unlawfully target concerned U.S. citizens who object to the Muslim Brotherhood-Marxist alliance that continues to influence the current presidential administration.

When planning, organizing, and equipping its cadres for the October 7 attack on Israel, HAMAS had ample lead time to coordinate and synchronize activities with other Islamic efforts. Given the murderous nature of the planned attacks, an assessment had to be made that, if the IDF responded in force, Gaza/HAMAS lacked the combat power to sustain operations.

To ease pressure on Gaza, large-scale influence operations would be undertaken, including sustained active measures in international forums, public relations, and legal tribunals at the international, national, and local levels across all targeted venues.

This included early media blitzes designed to liquify the meaning of “genocide,” pursuit of legal and diplomatic objectives, and, most noticeably, campus and street activities at varying levels of violence.

In effect, all events observed since October 7 should be understood as having been staffed and resourced during the planning cycles preceding October 7.

Not just Gaza, but also Turkey, Qatar, Iran, and the OIC. Not just Hamas, but also the Muslim Brotherhood, both internationally and domestically, across every targeted jurisdiction. Hence, the synthetic nature of the street narratives reflects the preplanning required to coordinate the full range of activities for maximal exploitation.

“Everything Everywhere All at Once” is never the product of a random unfolding of events.

What follows is a brief timeline of events, a sketch designed to highlight indicators of a substantial buildup of Islamic intent that provided warning of hostile intent by the Islamic Movement worldwide. (This timeline is even more streamlined due to the acceleration of events.)

This assessment assumes the accuracy of inter-Islamic synchronization, as in “[Burning Down the House](#),” and the stable interactive relationship between the Islamic Movement and the Marxist Left, as first explained in “[Defeating the Islamic Movement Inside the United States: A Strategic Plan](#).”

For a detailed tactical explanation of what these two papers discuss, Yaacov Apelbaum wrote [Domestic Terror 2.0](#) in February 2020. *Domestic Terror 2.0* vividly depicts how the Islamic Movement and the Marxist Left were fully integrated for the ground game that would unfold later in 2020. *It* was written months before the events described. In many respects, the main actors of 2020 are simply the same players, rebranded for their current roles in 2024.

Summer 2021. *The Christian Nationalism Line of Operation.*

The Islamic Movement in America escalated the Christian Nationalism narrative. For the purposes of this assessment, Christian Nationalism is the united-front active measure undertaken by the Muslim Brotherhood, led by organizations such as the USCMO and CAIR domestically, the International Muslim Brotherhood internationally (for example, see the following [ThreadReaderApp](#) thread), and state actors such as Turkey, Qatar, Pakistan, and Iran, along with international Islamic organizations and the Left (for example, see “[The Rise of the Narrative Term: ‘Christian Nationalism’](#)”).

A united front because they are allied with Marxist organizations such as the *A.N.S.W.E.R. Coalition*

unconstrained analytics An established *Marxist / IM* relationship with a substantial pedigree complete with common memes: *COEXIST* & (*Repressive*) *Tolerance*

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For the IM, patriotic Christians constitute the most powerful pro-Israel lobby in the United States and, hence, must be targeted. At the same time, the Marxist left targets patriotic Christians because they are among the most powerful groups supporting populist movements like MAGA and candidates like Trump.

The Christian Nationalism effort is a united-front tactic by the Islamic Movement to alienate pro-Israel Christians along antisemitic lines. At the same time, Marxists seek to disenfranchise them from the political process, following the January 6 model.

On his [X](#) account, Bob Roberts, Jr. reinforced this united front and commended the Qatari government's role as a broker in negotiations between Israel and HAMAS.

Associated with this line of operation is a range of synthetic players seeking to generate both positive and negative attention through narratives that intensify a break and penetrate target populations.

There are indications that this activity will escalate around the end of July 2024, with the arrival of Prime Minister Netanyahu, and will continue through the week leading up to the Christian Pro-Israel group "[Christians United for Israel](#)" (CUFI).

In March 2023, China brokered a truce between Iran and Saudi Arabia.

Within the Islamic domain, Wahhabi Sunni Muslims and Shia are existential threats to each other, permanent theological enemies. Hence, when brokering the truce, China opened a window of opportunity that could only be understood as time-sensitive and time-limited.

Whatever was in pre-operational planning initiated the transition to the operational phase. It goes without saying that China, Iran, and Saudi Arabia are state actors preparing the operational environment in advance of October 7.



June 15, 2023. Mohammed Al-Issa met with Antonio Guterres.

The Islamic Movement and the United Nations are aligned along the interoperable Islamophobia/Hate Speech line of effort (LOE).

Al-Issa is the General Secretary of the Saudi-controlled, Wahhabi-oriented Muslim World League (WML). Antonio Guterres is the Socialist leader of the United Nations (UN).

The meeting culminated a yearlong effort by Al-Issa to visit various religious entities, including Jewish and Christian groups, as well as national leaders, to align them with upcoming efforts.

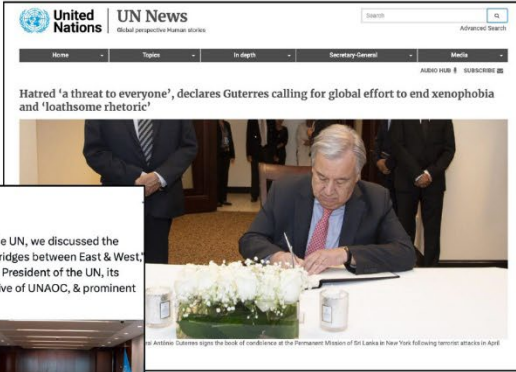
This meeting signaled that events were entering a synchronization process at the highest international levels, facilitating interoperable command and control across all levels of engagement.
